



Mary Jane LaBelle Scholarship Guidelines

Updated: January 24, 2022

Intent:

To provide financial assistance for members to pursue career objectives within the realm of medical financial auditing.

Areas included:

- Annual AAMAS conference and/or the preconference
- Certification (CCFA, CPC) test exam fees
- AAMAS webinars

Eligibility:

- Must be a member in good standing for two (2) or more years, or for one (1) year that includes a mentorship on the Board of Directors.
- Current AAMAS Board members and Committee Chairs are not eligible

Applications:

- Applications must be submitted to info@aamas.org between January 1 and December 10. The scholarship will be awarded by January 31 of the following year.
- Applications must be submitted by the member requesting the scholarship.
- Applications will be forwarded to the AAMAS Board of Directors for review. The Board will determine the best candidate based on length of membership, and/or involvement with the AAMAS Board of Directors.
- One scholarship in the amount of \$250 will be awarded annually in January of the following year. Scholarship is valid for two years from date of issue and has no monetary value.
- Should AAMAS not receive any applications during the specified year and/or go unused by the deadlines, scholarships will be returned to the scholarship fund.
- Previous scholarship winners may only apply every five (5) years.
